Ordinance No. 1 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, on behalf of the City of North Canton, to enter into an agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) cooperative purchasing program to contract for the purchase of sodium chloride (rock salt) for the 2020-2021 winter season, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, Section 5513.01(B) of the Revised Code provides the opportunity for the Ohio turnpike and infrastructure commission, any political subdivision, and any state university or college to participate in contracts with ODOT for the purchase of machinery, material, supplies, or other articles; and

WHEREAS, the City of North Canton is in need of rock salt for the 2020-2021 winter season, and because historically, the City has not received sufficient notice to participate in the cooperative purchase program by utilizing our general legislative process, time is of the essence to place it in position to timely respond and ensure our participation, thus obtaining the best price available for rock salt to maintain clear our roadways during the winter season.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor be, and is hereby authorized, on behalf of the City of North Canton, to enter into an agreement to participate in the ODOT contract for the purchase of rock salt for the 2020-2021 winter season.
- Section 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of North Canton to be bound by all terms and conditions as the Director of Transportation prescribes.
- Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to agree in the name of the City of North Canton to directly pay vendors, under each such contract of the Ohio Department of Transportation in which the City of North Canton participates.
- Section 4. That the City of North Canton shall be responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchasing program under Section 5513.01(B) of the Revised Code. The City of North Canton releases and forever discharges the Director of Transportation and ODOT from all such claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of its participation in the cooperative purchase program that the City of North Canton may have or claim to

have against ODOT or its employees, unless such liability is the result of negligence on the part of ODOT or its employees.

Section 5. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 6. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to ensure the City is able to promptly take advantage of the cost-saving measures through the ODOT cooperative purchasing program; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Ordinance No. 2 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, certain City streets and alleys require resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to advertise, receive bids, and enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys.

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriations:

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely bidding process and to enter into a contract in order for the 2020 Street Resurfacing Program to begin in a timely manner during weather-permitting conditions; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

Ordinance No. 3 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids, according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the complete reconstruction of Pineview Avenue SE from Bachtel Street SE to Schneider Street SE, including new concrete curbs and gutters, concrete driveway aprons, catch basins, and full-depth asphalt pavement, at a total cost not to exceed \$600,000.00, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, Pineview Avenue SE requires complete reconstruction, including new concrete curbs and gutters, concrete driveway aprons, catch basins, and full-depth asphalt pavement; and

WHEREAS, the City must advertise, receive, and evaluate bids, determine the lowest and best bidder, and complete the reconstruction during a brief, weather-permitting window.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, for the complete reconstruction of Pineview Avenue SE.

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the complete reconstruction of Pineview Avenue SE, as described above, at a total cost not to exceed \$600,000.00.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified contract from the following appropriations:

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to advertise, receive, and evaluate bids, determine the lowest and best bidder, and finish the complete reconstruction of Pineview Avenue SE, as described above, in order to bid and commence construction as early as possible; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its adoption by Council, together with the Board of Control and Mayor's approval. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract for the repaving of Portage Street from Wise Avenue, east to Charlotte Street, and from Charlotte and Portage Streets, east to North Main Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City, and further necessary for the timely bid process and completion of the Portage Street Resurfacing Project during limited weather-permitting conditions, and as the construction date was accelerated from fiscal year 2021 to 2020 as a result of the Stark County Area Transportation Study; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

- Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to obtain and thoroughly analyze a voluminous amount of comprehensive insurance proposals and to ensure no gap in insurance coverage; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
