Ordinance No. 2 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, certain City streets and alleys, as more fully described in Exhibit "A", (the "2020 Street Resurfacing Program"), attached hereto and incorporated herein, require resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to advertise, receive bids, and enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of the above-described City streets and alleys.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Director of Administration, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids according to specifications now on file in the Director's office for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of certain City streets and alleys, as more fully described in Exhibit "A".

Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the resurfacing, repaving, replacement, repair, and preventative maintenance of the above-described City streets and alleys.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above-specified contract from the following appropriations:

upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the timely bidding process and to enter into a contract in order for the 2020 Street Resurfacing Program to begin in a timely manner during weather-permitting conditions; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.

2020 LIMITS AND SCOPE OF WORK

The following streets shall be treated by grinding and removing approximately 1-1/2" of existing pavement surface. Additional milling at a 3" depth for additional, as directed contingency repairs, if required, shall be done at this time. The milled surface shall be broom cleaned, and item #407 applied at a rate of .07 gallon per square yard. An asphalt surface course shall be installed and compacted to 1-1/2". Manholes shall be set to finish grade, as directed, using the "MR. MANHOLE" procedure including new frames and new City logo lids.
