1                   MAYOR WILDER: Good morning, everyone.  
2                   This is Mayor Steve Wilder for the North  
3                   Canton Board of Control meeting scheduled for  
4                   9:00 a.m. for April 29, 2021. The correct  
5                   time is 9:08. Sorry for the delay. Just a  
6                   little bit of a technical difficulty.

7                   First order of business is call to order.  
8                   Finance Director, Jina Alaback.

9                   MS. ALABACK: Here.

10                  MAYOR WILDER: Here.

11                  MS. ALABACK: Here.

12                  MAYOR WILDER: Director of  
13                  Administration, Patrick DeOrio.

14                  MR. DEORIO: Here.

15                  MAYOR WILDER: Director of Law, Wayne  
16                  Boyer.

17                  MR. BOYER: Here.

18                  MAYOR WILDER: And Mayor Steve Wilder,  
19                  present. Four present.

20                  Third order of business is approval of  
21                  minutes, March 24, 2021, as presented in your  
22                  packets.

23                  MR. DEORIO: Move to adopt. Move to  
24                  adopt.

25                  MS. ALABACK: Alaback, second.

1                   MAYOR WILDER: DeOrio; second by Alaback.

2                   Any discussion on the minutes?

3                   (No response.)

4                   MAYOR WILDER: If not, all in favor, say  
5                   "aye."

6                   MR. DEORIO: Aye.

7                   MAYOR WILDER: Aye.

8                   MS. ALABACK: Aye.

9                   MR. BOYER: Aye.

10                  MAYOR WILDER: Opposed?

11                  (No response.)

12                  MAYOR WILDER: The minutes are approved.

13                  Fourth order, new business, drinking  
14                  water plant chemicals.

15                  MR. DEORIO: Mr. Chair, I'd like to speak  
16                  to this.

17                  MAYOR WILDER: Go ahead, Mr. DeOrio.

18                  MR. DEORIO: Yeah. So we had bid opening  
19                  on April 21st of this year at 11:00 for  
20                  drinking water plant chemicals. This was our  
21                  second bid effort. The first bid effort  
22                  resulted in some chemicals not receiving a  
23                  bid.

24                  So in this go-round, we did receive bids  
25                  on the remaining chemicals. So in the CO2,

1 the carbon dioxide, the sole bid was from Air  
2 Products at \$145 a ton. They are our current  
3 vendor.

4 So I think it would be appropriate that  
5 we handle these one at a time. Being that  
6 they are the only vendor, I would move that  
7 we accept the bid from Air Products and award  
8 a contract to them at \$145 a ton.

9 MAYOR WILDER: The motion is on the floor  
10 to accept Air Products' bid of \$145 per ton.  
11 May I have a second to that?

12 MR. BOYER: Boyer seconds.

13 MS. ALABACK: Second.

14 MAYOR WILDER: Boyer seconds. Any other  
15 discussion on awarding that bid?

16 (No response.)

17 MAYOR WILDER: If not, all in favor, say  
18 "aye."

19 MR. DEORIO: Aye.

20 MAYOR WILDER: Aye.

21 MS. ALABACK: Aye.

22 MR. BOYER: Aye.

23 MAYOR WILDER: Opposed?

24 (No response.)

25 MAYOR WILDER: That award is approved for

1 Air Products.

2 MR. DEORIO: Okay. Mr. Chair, the next  
3 one is for lime. And we had two bids; one  
4 from Carmeuse, C-a-r-m-e-u-s-e, at \$240 per  
5 ton, and the other from Greer Lime,  
6 G-r-e-e-r, and theirs was \$217 per ton.  
7 Greer is the vendor that we use presently.  
8 So we have been very happy with them. We  
9 have no issues with Greer and the product  
10 that they have been delivering the last few  
11 years.

12 So the -- I would recommend, based on  
13 discussions with the superintendent, that we  
14 award the lime chemical bid to Greer Lime at  
15 \$217 a ton.

16 MAYOR WILDER: Very well. The motion is  
17 on the floor to award Greer Lime for the lime  
18 product at \$217 per ton. Can I have a second  
19 to that motion?

20 MR. BOYER: Boyer seconds.

21 MS. ALABACK: Second.

22 MAYOR WILDER: Boyer seconds. Any  
23 further discussion on that item?

24 (No response.)

25 MAYOR WILDER: If not, all in favor, say

1 "aye."

2 MR. DEORIO: Aye.

3 MAYOR WILDER: Aye.

4 MS. ALABACK: Aye.

5 MR. BOYER: Aye.

6 MAYOR WILDER: Opposed?

7 (No response.)

8 MAYOR WILDER: The award is granted to  
9 Greer Lime. Thank you.

10 MR. DEORIO: Finally, Mr. Chair, we have  
11 the soda ash, and we had two bidders, Univar  
12 Solutions, and Bonded Chemicals. Bonded  
13 Chemicals' bid was \$321.25 per ton. Univar  
14 was \$331 per ton. Bonded was the lowest at  
15 \$10 less. They also are the current vendor.  
16 We have had no issues or problems with them.

17 Being that they were the lowest, as well,  
18 we would recommend, and I would so move, that  
19 Bonded Chemicals be awarded the bid at  
20 \$321.25 per ton for soda ash.

21 MAYOR WILDER: Very well. Motion is on  
22 the floor to award Bonded Chemicals the soda  
23 ash contract at \$321.25 per ton. May I have  
24 a second to that motion?

25 MR. BOYER: Boyer seconds.

1                   MAYOR WILDER: Boyer seconds. Any  
2 further discussion on that?

3                   (No response.)

4                   MAYOR WILDER: If not, all in favor, say  
5 "aye."

6                   MR. DEORIO: Aye.

7                   MAYOR WILDER: Aye.

8                   MS. ALABACK: Aye.

9                   MR. BOYER: Aye.

10                  MAYOR WILDER: Opposed?

11                  (No response.)

12                  MAYOR WILDER: Very well. Bonded  
13 Chemicals has been awarded that contract. Is  
14 there anything further regarding the drinking  
15 water plant chemicals, Mr. DeOrio?

16                  MR. DEORIO: That concludes the bid.

17                  MAYOR WILDER: Very well. With no  
18 further business, I'll just request a motion  
19 to adjourn.

20                  MS. ALABACK: So moved.

21                  MAYOR WILDER: So moved, Alaback.

22                  MR. DEORIO: Second.

23                  MAYOR WILDER: Second by Mr. DeOrio. All  
24 in favor, say "aye."

25                  MR. DEORIO: Aye.
