Ordinance No. 82-13

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, to enter into a Jobs and Commerce Economic Development Agreement ("Agreement") by and between the City of North Canton ("City") and the State of Ohio Department of Transportation ("ODOT"), for the purpose of funding the East Maple Street (from Main Street to Taft Avenue NE and to realign McKinley Avenue SE) Improvements Project, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, through the Board of Control, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement by and between the City and the ODOT, for the purpose of funding the East Maple Street (from Main Street to Taft Avenue NE and to realign McKinley Avenue SE) Improvements Project, in an amount not to exceed \$150,000.

Section 2. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriation:



upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.

Section 3. That, if any provision of this Ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid or unenforceable, that shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, and safety of the City of North Canton and further necessary for timely funding and completion of the East Maple Street Improvements Project; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six (6) or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
