
ORDINANCE NO. 20-79


An ordinance authorizing the Board of County Commissioners of Stark County Ohio and the Office of the Stark County Prosecutor, James R. Unger, to acquire necessary right of way within the City of North Canton under authority of Section 307.15 of the OHIO REVISED CODE for the purpose of the improvement of Whipple Avenue from Everhard Road northerly to Portage Street, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Board of County Commissioners of Stark County Ohio and the Office of the Stark County Prosecutor, James R. Unger, be, and are hereby authorized to acquire necessary right of way within the City of North Canton under authority of Section 307.15 of the OHIO REVISED CODE for the purpose of the improvement of Whipple Avenue from Everhard Road northerly to Portage Street.
- Section 2. That this ordinance is authorized pursuant to an amended agreement between the County of Stark and the City of North Canton authorized by Ordinance No. 8-79, adopted by the North Canton City Council on January 8, 1979.
- Section 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary for the expeditious acquisition of right of way for a necessary highway improvement within the corporate limits of the City of North Canton, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon adoption and approval by the Mayor.
