

ORDINANCE NO. 36-79

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton, Ohio, to enter into an auction sale contract for the disposition of equipment and miscellaneous items which are no longer required for municipal purposes, and declaring it to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That it is declared that the following equipment and miscellaneous items are no longer required for municipal purposes:

Section 2. That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and he is hereby authorized to enter into an auction sales contract for the disposition of equipment and miscellaneous items designated in Section 1. of the within ordinance.

Section 3. That the Director of Finance is hereby directed to deposit the proceeds of the sale of the auction sale contract to the credit of the various City funds from which said equipment was originally purchased.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and immediately necessary for the timely establishment of an auction date in order to enable the timely deposit of the proceeds of the sale of the action sale contract to the credit of the various City funds from which said equipment was originally purchased, and shall take effect and be in force upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
