ORDINANCE NO. 46-79

An ordinance authorizing the sale of City owned property located at the northwest corner of West Maple Street and Lindy Lane and being further described as O.L. 103 in the City of North Canton by the Sewer Revenue Fund at the original purchase price of \$1,000.00 to the Capital Improvement Fund, and declaring it to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That there be and is hereby authorized the sale of City owned property located at the northwest corner of West Maple Street and Lindy Lane and being further described as O.L. 103 in the City of North Canton by the Sewer Revenue Fund at the original purchase price of \$1,000.00 to the Capital Improvement Fund.
- Section 2. That the original acquisition of said City property, be, and is hereby noted in Volume 1., Page 28 of the COUNCIL RECORD, dated December 3, 1912.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and is hereby authorized to issue his warrants for the payment by the Capital Improvement Fund and depositing said payment to the credit of the Sewer Revenue Fund upon vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio, and immediate necessary to authorize the sale of property which has not been used for the purpose for which it was purchased from the Sewer Revenue Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund so it may be better used in the service of the City of North Canton, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption by the Mayor.


