

ORDINANCE NO. 91-79

An ordinance changing the name of Ronald Avenue, N.W. from its terminus at Postiy Street, N.W. in a northerly direction to the corporate limits of the City of North Canton to Barchester Avenue, N.W., and declaring the same to be an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 87-79, the Council of the City of North Canton may, by an affirmative vote of its members, change the name of Ronald Avenue, N.W. which is an existing street within the corporate limits of the City of North Canton extending outside the corporate limits and is known by another name.
- Section 2. That the name of the street Ronald Avenue, N.W. from its terminus at Postiy Street, N.W. in a northerly direction to the corporate limits of the City of North Canton be, and is hereby changed to Barchester Avenue, N.W.
- Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, and out of the necessity to eliminate any confusion with regard to residential addresses for Emergency Medical Service, Police Department and Fire Department services without delay and in order to correct a situation now deemed undesirable, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
