ORDINANCE NO. 125-79

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 43-79, passed by the North Canton City Council March 26, 1979, by the authorization of an additional \$530.00 to be expended for the rebuilding of the water pump and the replacement of the 1,000 gallon water reservoir of the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment owned by the City of North Canton and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of North Canton adopted Ordinance No. 43-79, March 26, 1979, authorizing the Mayor of the City of North Canton to enter into a contract for the rebuilding of the water pump and the replacement of the 1,000 gallon water reservoir of the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment owned by the City of North Canton without advertisement and competitive bidding at a price not to exceed \$7,650; and

WHEREAS, the final cost of the work actually performed on the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment exceeded the original estimate by \$530.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 2. and Section 3. of Ordinance No. 43-79 passed by the North Canton City Council March 26, 1979, be, and is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2.

That the Mayor of the City of North Canton, be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the rebuilding of the water pump and the replacement of the 1,000 gallon water reservoir of the 1970 Sewer Jet equipment owned by the City of North Canton at a price not to exceed \$8,180.

Section 3.

That the Director of Finance of the City of North Canton, be, and he is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from the following appropriation:

30-611	Sanitary Sewer Maintenance Dept.
A/C 30-611-24	Maintenance of Equipment
	\$8,180.00"

Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton, Ohio and immediately necessary for timely payment of invoices submitted to the City for the efficient maintenance of the sewers of the City of North Canton, and shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
