ORDINANCE 73 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the appropriation of funds received under Section 5001 of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act) for current expenses during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, ~~creating related funds~~, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, the City wishes to utilize its remaining Cares Act funds to offset the wages of qualifying safety services personnel during the period of March 1, 2020, to December 30, 2020.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists in that the City must spend all funds received through the CARES Act by December 31, 2020.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That to provide for the current expenses and other expenditures of the City of North Canton, during the fiscal year ending December 31, 2020, the following funds, be, and are hereby set aside and appropriated as follows:

Section 2. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety and peace of the City of North Canton; and further necessary to meet the spending deadline of December 31, 2020, under the CARES Act; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force upon its adoption by Council, together with the Mayor's approval. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
