ORDINANCE 75 - 2020

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Administration of the City of North Canton to advertise and receive bids, according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, for the purchase of Water Treatment Plant chemicals for use by the City's Drinking Water Treatment Plant, and authorizing the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, to enter into a contract for the purchase of said chemicals, and declaring the same to be an emergency.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the City to seek bids, determine the lowest and best bidder, and enter into a contract for the purchase of chemicals for the North Canton Drinking Water Treatment Plant, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into a contract for the purchase of chemicals for the North Canton Drinking Water Treatment Plant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORTH CANTON, COUNTY OF STARK, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Director of Administration, be, and is hereby authorized to advertise and receive bids, according to specifications now on file in the Director's office, for the purchase of Water Treatment Plant chemicals for use by the City's Drinking Water Treatment Plant.
- Section 2. That the Mayor, upon Board of Control approval, be, and is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of chemicals at the Water Treatment Plant.
- Section 3. That the Director of Finance, be, and is hereby authorized to draw funds necessary for the payment of the above specified contract from applicable appropriations upon receipt of vouchers duly approved by the proper departmental authority.
- Section 4. That if a provision of this ordinance is or becomes illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, it shall not affect the validity or enforceability of any other provision of this ordinance.
- Section 5. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the health, safety, and peace of the City of North Canton and further necessary to ensure the City is able to promptly seek bids and ensure the availability of chemicals necessary to protect the City's water supply; wherefore, provided it receives the affirmative vote of six or more members of Council elected thereto, this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force immediately upon its adoption by Council and approval by the Mayor. Otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
